3 WAYS TO RAISE FUNDS

(Yes, you can utilize a combination of any of the fundraising forms)

- Online Ordering:** We make it easy for you! Supporters order directly through our website for your fundraiser using a 'coupon code' that identifies the order for your fundraiser. Social media images are provided for promotion and we ship all orders directly to each supporter across the United States. Your supporters have access to order any of our online products.
- Old Fashion Paper Order Forms:** If you prefer participants to utilize physical order forms, we offer a small selection of our "Best Sellers" across a few candy categories to be featured. Your organization will be responsible for self-distributing these orders to supporters.
- In-Store Event:** If your organization is in the Oklahoma City area, we're happy to schedule a date and time for an in-store fundraising event. This option is limited to 10% of purchases being contributed to your organization's fundraiser.

Retail value sold	Profit
\$100-\$2,500	20%*
\$2,501-\$5,000	30%*
\$5,001 +	40%*

*Retail value sold does not include tax and shipping on each online fundraiser order

PROFIT POTENTIAL EXAMPLES:

(the average order is usually close to \$40)

- 10 participants selling \$200 each = \$400 profit
- 10 participants selling \$500 each = \$1,500 profit**
- 10 participants selling \$1,000 each = \$4,000 profit

- 15 participants selling \$200 each = \$900 profit
- 15 participants selling \$500 each = \$3,000 profit**
- 15 participants selling \$1,000 each = \$6,000 profit
